

ABOUT THE WW FOUNDATION 50-STATE AMERICAN HISTORY KNOWLEDGE DATA

In February 2019, the Woodrow Wilson National Fellowship Foundation released the results of a survey of 41,000 Americans and their knowledge of basic American history facts.

Among all 50 states and the District of Columbia, Vermont was the only state to pass the 20-question multiple-choice test based on previous years' practice exams for the U.S. Citizenship test. The top five highest states after Vermont are: Wyoming, South Dakota, Montana, Nebraska, and Virginia. The five lowest performing states are: Mississippi, Alabama, Arkansas, Kentucky and Louisiana at the bottom of the list.

Lincoln Park Strategies (<u>https://lpstrategies.com</u>) conducted the poll for the Foundation. It involved 41,000 interviews among adults nationwide. The margin of error for the total national is approximately ± 1.0 percent. Individual state results posted a margin of error of approximately ± 4.0 percent.
